Where it is legally required, or necessary (and it complies with UK data protection law), we may share personal information about you with:

- Our local authority [name of local authority] – to meet our legal obligations to share certain information with it, such as safeguarding concerns
- Government departments or agencies
- Our regulator, Ofsted
- Our auditors – Streets (external audit) and Haines Watts (internal audit)
- Health authorities
- Security organisations
- Professional advisers and consultants
- Police forces, courts, tribunals
